Date and Time - Saturday, May 1, 2021; 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Positions and Terms – Three (3) Trustees for three-year terms; and One (1) Trustee for a one-year term.

Election Day Voting – All polling places shall be open on Election day, Saturday, May 1, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Early Voting - In person: from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each weekday, from Monday, April 19, 2021 through Tuesday, April 27, 2021, at the **Beaumont Courthouse-Main location**, 1001 Pearl St., Beaumont, Texas; **Port Arthur Sub-Courthouse**, 525 Lakeshore Dr., Port Arthur, Texas; **Rogers Park Recreation Center**, 6540 Gladys, Beaumont, Texas; **Port Arthur Public Library**, 4615 Ninth Ave, Port Arthur, Texas; **Theodore Johns Library**, 4255 Fannett Rd., Beaumont, Texas; and **John Paul Davis Community Center**, 3580 E Lucas, Beaumont. Additional hours may be extended by Jefferson County as administrator of election.

Applications for ballots by mail shall be mailed to: Office of the County Clerk, Carolyn Guidry, 1085 Pearl Street, Beaumont, Texas 77704; applications for ballot by mail must be received no later than the close of business (4:30pm) on Tuesday, April 20, 2021.

Candidates – All applications by trustee candidates seeking to have their names placed on the ballot for this election shall be in writing on the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, State of Texas, and signed by the candidate. Applications are to be presented to Ms. Phyllis Geans or Ms. Margaret Moreno at the office of the Chief Financial Officer, Port Arthur Independent School District Administration Building, 4801 9th Avenue, Port Arthur, TX 77642, between 7:30 a.m. and

4:00 p.m. on any weekday, exclusive of holidays, beginning Wednesday, January 13, 2021 and concluding at 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 12, 2021.

Election - All PAISD voters may vote for three (3) trustees for three-year terms and one (1) trustee for an unexpired one-year term; election by plurality; that is, no run-off election. The three candidates receiving the greatest number of votes will each be elected for three-year terms. The one candidate receiving the greatest number of votes for the one-year unexpired term will be elected for a one-year term.
